



2007 Dark Horse Peacemaker Diamond Mountain District Cabernet

The Vineyards

The grapes for our Peacemaker Diamond Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon are grown on the spectacular Constant-Diamond Mountain Vineyard, which rises to 2200 feet elevation above the Napa Valley floor. The vineyards nestle on a northeastern slope, where mornings are typically brisk and fog-free, while northwesterly winds continue to cool the vineyard throughout the growing season. This unique mountain vineyard site provides a variety of soils, superior sun exposure, and nighttime cooling—producing small, intense, full-flavored berries.

Tasting Notes

This is what Cabernet is all about! It is a big, bold wine with intense fruit, a full body and a long smooth finish. The 2007 vintage offers lush blackberry, anise and cherry at the beginning, with hints of clove layered through out. Yeehaa!!! Pop this baby open and drink up.
